

OMU's Guide to Voter Registration: May's Special District Elections

Are you ready for May's Special District Election? Here are important dates and suggestions.

Who Can Register: A U.S. citizen, resident of Oregon, and at least 16 years old (DMV may automatically register drivers through the <u>Oregon Motor Voters Act</u>.) If you are not yet 18 years of age, you will not receive a ballot until an election occurs on or after your 18th birthday.

Register to Vote: Oregonians can register online, by mail, and in person.

- Online at <u>My Vote</u>- <u>https://secure.sos.state.or.us/orestar/vr/register.do</u> You'll need an Oregon driver's license, permit, or ID card number.
- In Person/Mail- A printed voter registration form must be signed and delivered/mailed to your county elections office to complete registration. <u>https://sos.oregon.gov/elections/Documents/SEL500.pdf</u>
- In-person forms may be filed at the voter's county elections office or the DMV.

Voter Registration Deadline: Tuesday, April 25 11:59:59pm A new registrant must submit their online registration by 11:59:59 p.m. Pacific Time on the 21st calendar day before the election.

- Register by Tuesday, April 25, 2023 (All mailed forms must be postmarked 4/25/23)
- Special District Election is Tuesday, May 16, 2023. Ballots are due by 8:00 pm/PST

Registered Voters: Annually, log onto <u>My Vote</u> to review your registration information including address, district, and affiliation.

- Check the status of your ballot
- Find contact information for your county elections office
- Find contact information for your elected officials
- Find a ballot drop site
