- 1. Volunteer in the classroom
- 2. Become an OMU Captain or co-captain for your school district.
- 3. Write an email to the school board director(s) thanking them for supporting students through their recent vote or statement
- 4. Ask for an OMU parent workshop to visit your area
- 5. Support a candidate running for school board
- 6. Ask your school board Chair for the annual budget
- 7. In your local community FB groups to post school board meetings and agenda
- 8. Support your school board candidate
- 9. Attend a legislative meeting at the state capital
- 10. Apply or join a district or school review board
- 11. Attend the next parent-teacher conference
- 12. Attend school events
- 13. Attend a PTSA meeting to learn about fundraising, grants, projects, etc. You don't have to be a paying member to attend or to contribute ideas
- 14. Assist in after-school activities
- 15. Log on to watch ODE meetings or hearings
- 16. Sign up to receive ODE newsletters
- 17. Receive school and district news
- 18. Participate in fundraisers
- 19. Apply for site council
- 20. Instead of emailing, ask to speak to the teacher or administrator in-person or by phone
- 21. Chaperone a field trip
- 22. Host a meet and greet for school board candidates
- 23. Invite a school board director to coffee
- 24. Read the books your student is assigned to read

- 25. Request curriculum
- 26. Vote in the May school board election
- 27. Apply for a school district committee
- 28. Ask a teacher how you can help outside the classroom
- 29. Consider running for school board
- 30. Thank teachers and staff
- 31. Attend school board meetings
